- ★ provide tools that enable committees to keep chapter members up-to-date on projects, membership, and other key items.

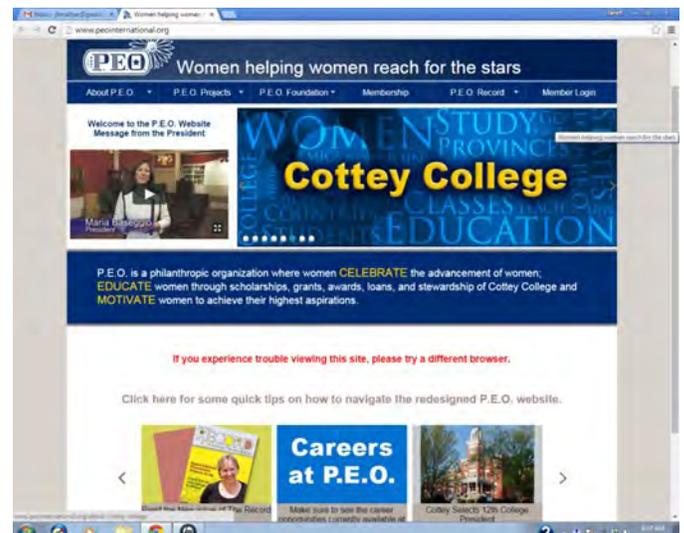
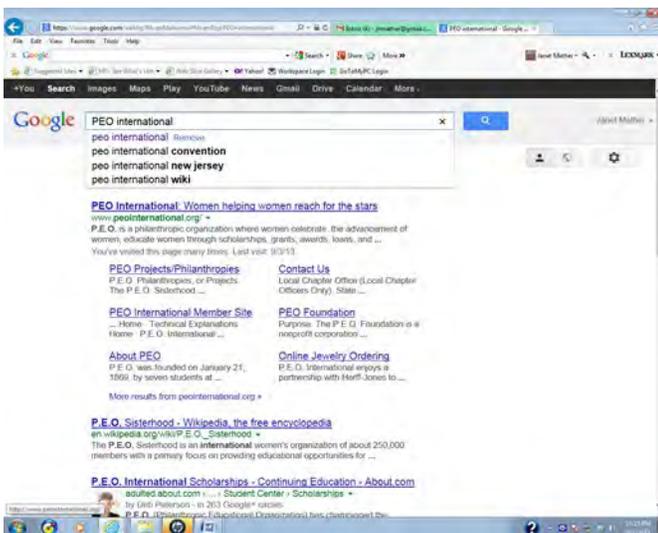


Figure 1. Enter **P.E.O. International** into the description box on the Search Engine home page, then click on www.peointernational.org

Manuals, **Instructions for Officers of Local Chapters (IOLC)**, and the **P.E.O. Constitution** are under **Manuals and Handbooks**.

Membership information is under **Membership**.

Reference listings include Bed and Breakfast homes, Gatherings Away From Home, etc. Graphic Images, Music, Program Ideas, Communications, and Local Chapter Trainings for Officers are all found under **Resources**.

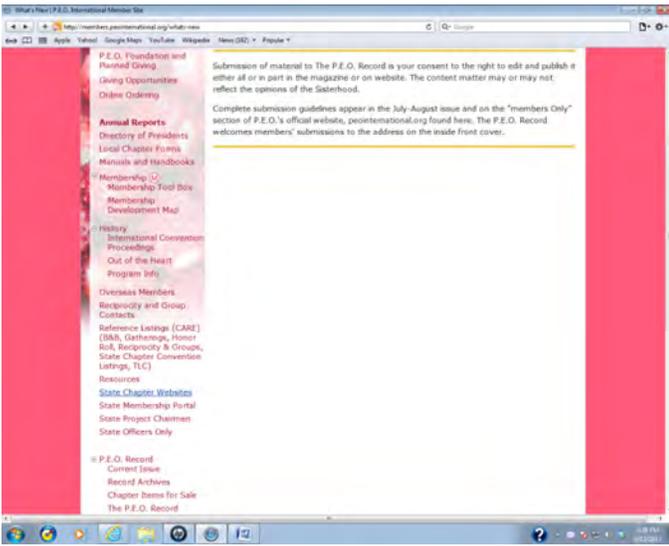


Figure 6. To find the Ohio State Chapter website, click on **State Chapter Websites**.

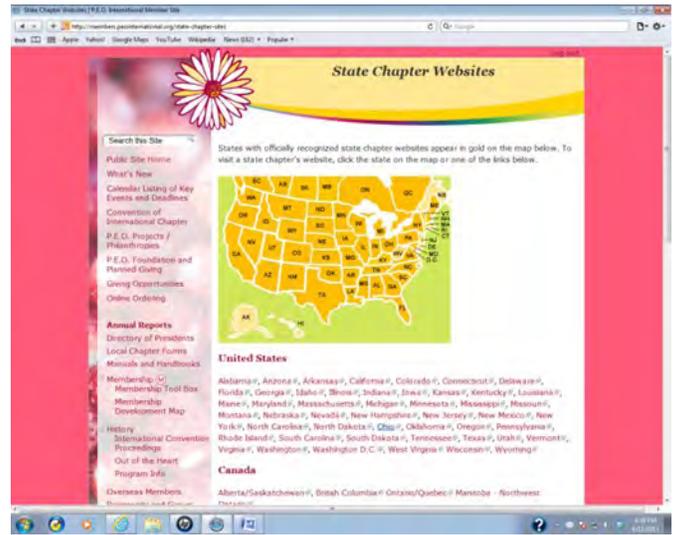


Figure 7. Click on **Ohio**.

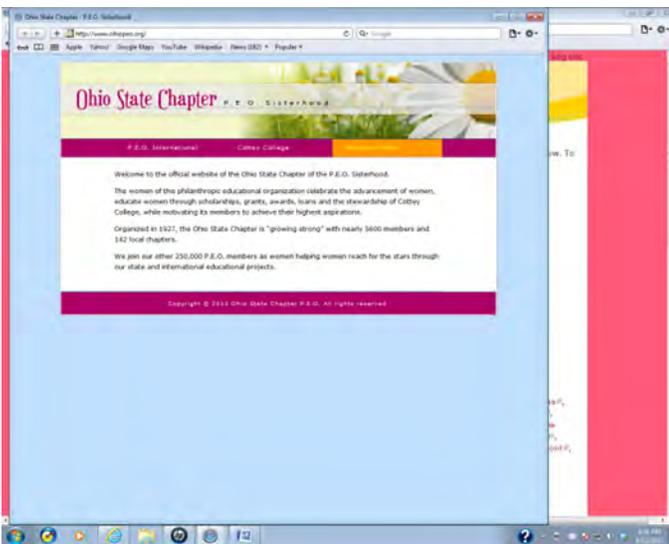


Figure 8. This is the public part of the Ohio State Chapter website. Clicking on **P.E.O. International** will link to the P.E.O. International website (Figure 2); **Cotley College** will link to Cotley's website; clicking on **Members Home** goes to the restricted part of the state website and the Login page.

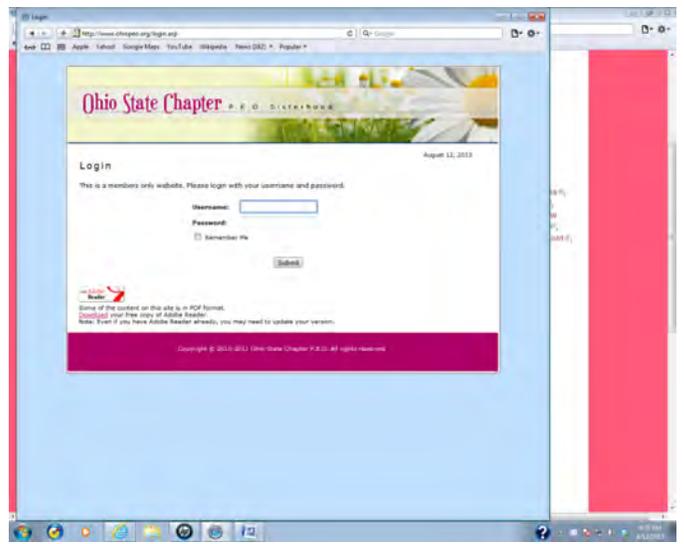


Figure 9. Type the same **Username** and **Password** as in Figure 3.

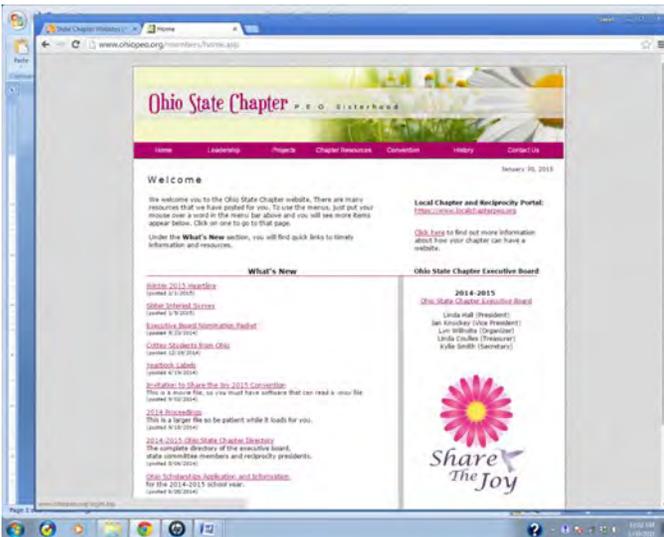


Figure 10. The Ohio State Chapter Home Page has a Welcome, as well as **What's New** information, such as the latest *Heartline* and the Directory of the State Chapter Officers and Committees.

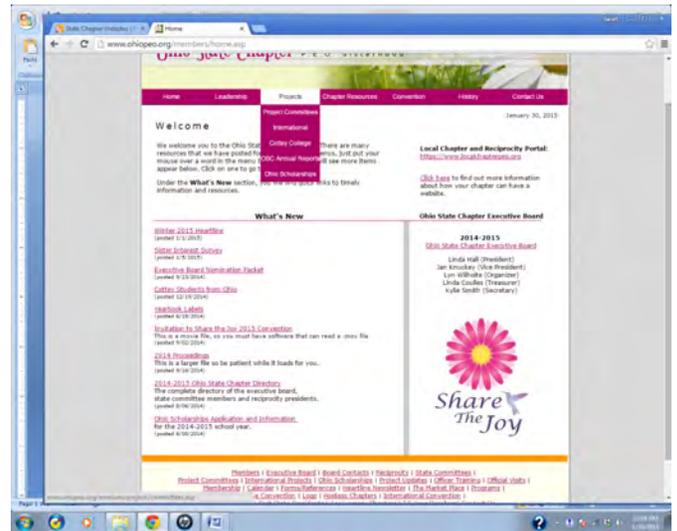


Figure 11. On the **Projects** drop down menu, Projects chairmen would find information about the **P.E.O. Projects**.

If neither symbol is present, the program can be ordered from the state History Committee Chairman for \$1.00.

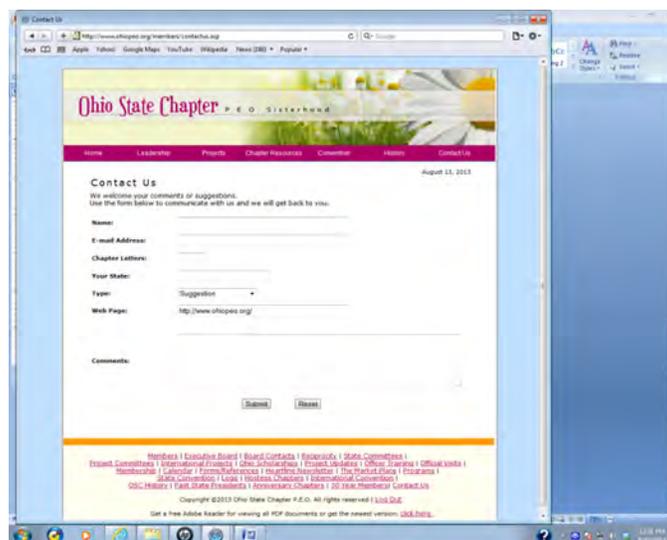


Figure 15. If there is a question about the website for which you cannot find an answer (e.g. a form that is referenced on the website cannot be located), use the "**Contact Us**" form; these inquiries go directly to the OSC President.
