An interactive game for chapters to play with information about the Heartline.

This interactive program is meant to be fun but informative. Some chapters may want to place the *Heartline* in a three-ring binder and make it available at every meeting for all to see and review at leisure.

Supplies:

emcee (name Daisy Hall)
large stars, numbered 1 - 2 - 3
shoe boxes (glue stars to box tops)
small gifts, placed in shoe boxes (star stickers, play money, Hot Wheels cars, etc.)

How:

The emcee asks questions to the chapter. The person who answers correctly gets to choose one of the boxes. Some may contain prizes, some might contain another question. You can be very creative in what you put behind the stars. If you remember, the TV show had nice prizes but they also had some clunkers. Just have fun! The object of this is to inform the entire chapter about the *Heartline*.

(Answer):	Three (3)
Question:	When are they issued?
(Answer):	Fall, Winter, and Spring
Question: (Answer):	What always appears on the front page of the <i>Heartline</i> ? The President's letter
Question:	When is the President's letter read during the chapter meeting?
(Answer):	Under correspondence
Question:	Who publishes the <i>Heartline</i> ?
(Answer):	The Ohio State Recording Secretary is the editor
Question: (Answer):	Where can any sister access the <i>Heartline</i> ? Anyone can review the Heartline by visiting the Ohio P.E.O. website at www.ohiopeo.org

Question: Can chapters place ads in the *Heartline*?

- (Answer): No, but chapters can place ads, free of charge, on the Ohio P.E.O. website
