October

- ★ Have a virtual cooking demonstration as a social with your chapter. Send out the recipe ahead of time. Make your own scrumptious fall dish or just watch and socialize.
- ★ How about an early morning walk with a sister you haven't seen in a while? Find a park or location with a nearby shop where you can enjoy donuts and coffee afterwards.
- ★ Deliver a seasonal card and a goody bag to a sister you have not connected with recently and invite her to go for pumpkin spice latte with you.
- ★ Plan a walking tour of a neighborhood that goes "all-out" with festive decorations. Make this an event open to all sisters; active, nonparticipating, unaffiliates and inactive.

November

- ★ Contact two members of your chapter by phone, mail, email and/or text and catch up with them.
- ★ Have a "Mixology by Zoomology" social. Contact an accomplished sister or mixologist who would be willing to do a short demonstration. Make sure to invite your nonresident members on the call.
- ★ Mail a card to all inactive and non-participating members of your chapter sharing your gratefulness for their friendship and sisterhood.
- ★ As a chapter, collect nonperishable food items. Decorate a box or basket to take your food items to a local food bank. Take pictures and share on social media. Your community will learn about P.E.O. and your chapter will feel good, too.

December

- ★ Make a date to see the light displays in your area as a chapter or in small groups. Invite your inactive and nonparticipating members to join you.
- ★ Buy a single flower for each member of your chapter. Attach a ribbon to each one. At the end of your meeting, give one to each sister as she leaves, and ask her to take one to drop off at the home of a sister who wasn't able to attend the meeting.
- ★ Gather in-person or virtually and get out your thread and needle. Pop some popcorn and include a bowl of fresh cranberries. Create a string full of old-fashioned splendor. Decorate your house with cheer. Invite guests, inactives and nonparticipating members. Your chapter could pair this activity with watching a movie or listening to music.
